ADVANCED LEGAL CLINIC

The advanced Legal Clinic offering is a three (3) credit-hour course. Students who have successfully completed and excelled in the regular legal clinic offering will work on more complicated cases and/or legal projects, and may have some supervisory duties over basic Legal Clinic students.

ADVANCED DISPUTE RESOLUTION CLINIC

The Advanced Dispute Resolution Clinic is a three (3) credit-hour course available to students who have successfully completed and excelled in the Dispute Resolution Clinic and wish to further their exposure to ADR. Students will observe and mediate in more complex cases in various courts throughout Northwest Ohio.

ADVANCED DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CLINIC

The Advanced Domestic Violence clinic is a one semester, four (4) credit-hour course in which students provide legal assistance to clients who experience interpersonal violence and/or participate in community-based domestic violence prevention collaborations.

PLEASE NOTE: Enrollment in the advanced clinic offerings is limited. Acceptance is determined by the clinical faculty on a case by case basis. Faculty will consider prior clinic performance, course size limitations, faculty resources, and the availability of appropriate legal work. Requirements for the course are negotiated by the students and the clinical faculty on an individualized basis prior to the commencement of the term.
