

CRIMINAL LAW PRACTICE PROGRAM APPLICATION

Semester in which you wish to take the Criminal Law Practice Program _____

Students work in local prosecutor offices either 16 hours per week (6 credit hour option) or 12 hours per week (4 credit hour option) and attend weekly classes on prosecutorial responsibilities and skills. Students must have completed the course in Evidence and be certified as legal interns (go to Records Office for forms) to practice in Ohio. To be eligible for legal intern certification a student must have completed two-thirds of the credits (59 credit hours) required for graduation. Students placed in Michigan placements may undertake both felony and misdemeanor representation after having completed only the first year of law school. All students are strongly urged to take the course in Criminal Procedure - Investigations. Priority for enrollment in the program will be given to graduating seniors who have not completed the College of Law Legal Clinic, the Dispute Resolution Clinic or the Judicial Internship.
