## Advanced Research and Writing Sections – Spring 2010

Each Fall and Spring semester every faculty member who is not on leave will offer a section of Advanced Research and Writing. Listed below are the topics on which each faculty member is prepared to supervise student papers for Spring 2010.

Ordinarily, if there is a substantive course offered in the subject area in which you wish to write a paper for Advanced Research and Writing, you must 1) have completed that course, **or** 2) be concurrently enrolled in that course, **or** 3) receive the prior permission of the instructor. Some instructors may require completion of that course and not just concurrent enrollment. To determine the requirements for a particular section, or to clarify its topics, you should contact the instructor before registering.

Each section will have a limited enrollment, and once that limit is reached that section will be closed. If your first choice for a section is closed, enrolling for Advanced Research and Writing in Spring 2010 would require selecting another section. If you wish to work only with a particular professor or professors and their sections are closed this Spring you will have to wait for a later semester. Registration takes place online through the ordinary registration process.
